Whatever your age, there's something for everyone!

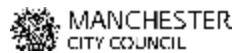

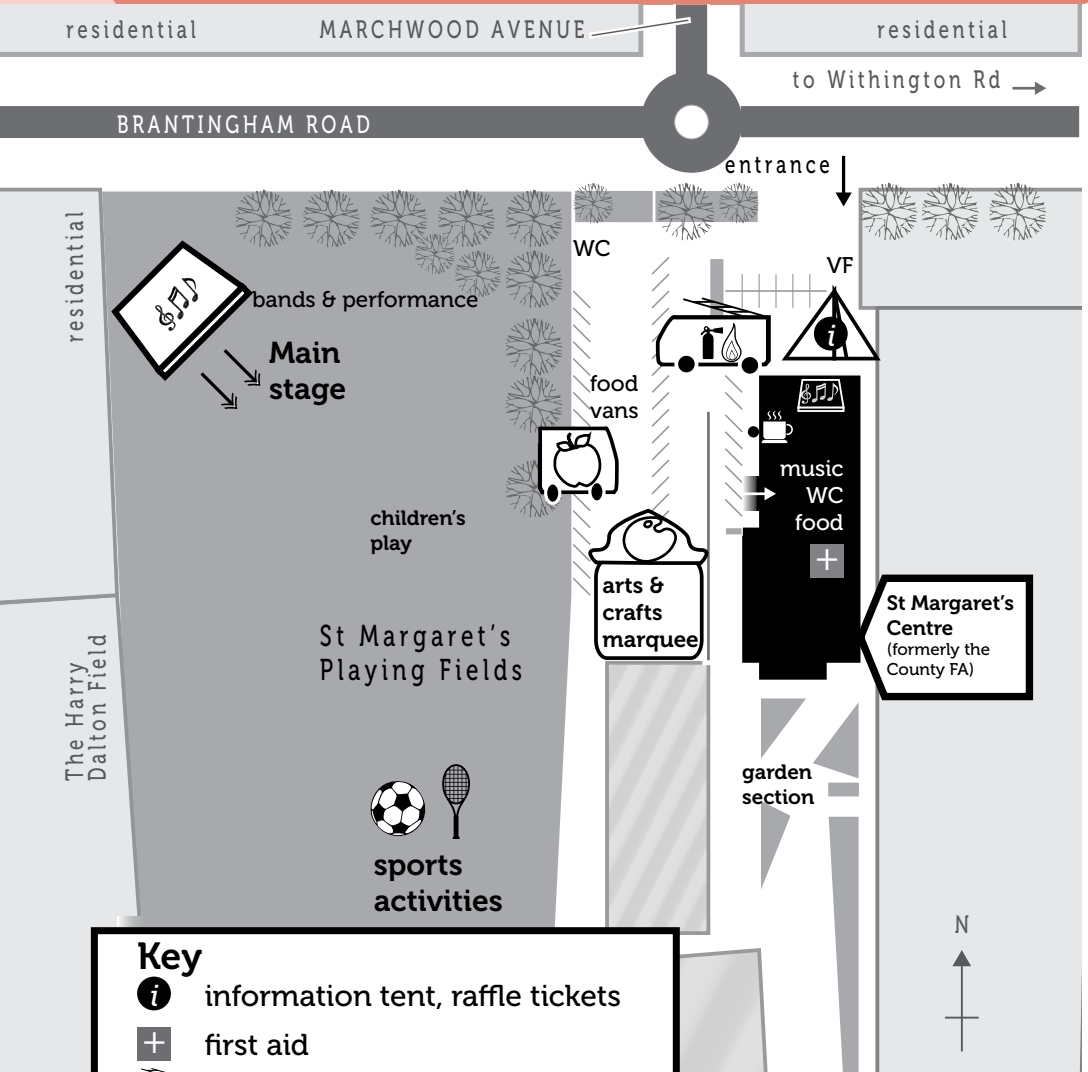
